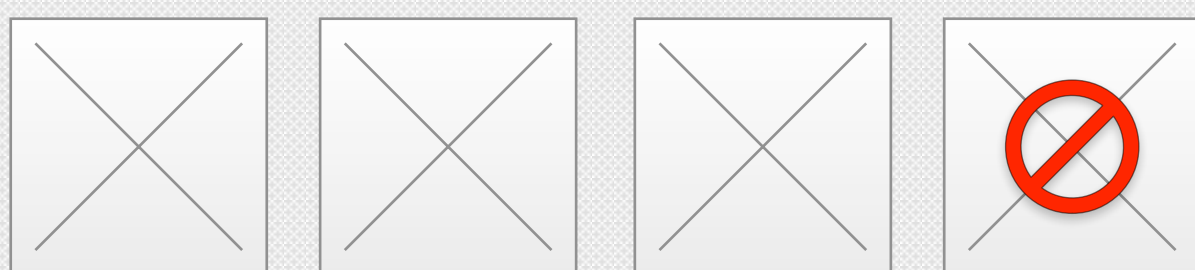

Notes on 1x back end

This would be our ideal back-end interface. The design of buttons, forms, and page backgrounds is all open-ended (don't know what Dan would like), but the features included here are the ones that we find necessary for efficiently adding a new product to the site.

This is an extended view, and ideally it would be compacted into tabs for each section. Many elements are already existing in our admin, but have been re-ordered based on categories.

Certain elements with radio buttons would call on pre-formatted text strings. For example [1.0]: clicking "giclee" in the product medium/type would place our default description –

[Giclee on 330gsm 100% Archival Cotton Paper]
on the product page.

It would also be very useful to have a WYSWYG editor [2.0] for the paragraph text fields. Currently a familiarity with HTML and formatting is necessary to add a product.

I used the term "default" for the product price field. What that means is that the minimum price of the product (before a frame or any special options) will be that set value. All other optional prices can be added below.

When a user selects their shipping region, they would see more choices than "United States" or "Outside the USA" if we want to include more specific shipping costs.

The image uploader needs to be modified to accept more than 4 images. I added an "ADD" button, which brings up the file browser to select another photo. Once selected, you are returned to the page, and you can add another if necessary.

The thumbnails above let you see the images already uploaded and you can delete any you don't want.

In addition to the publish button, which makes it go live to the website, admin users can click "preview" or "save." With preview, we would be able to check the formatting and images as it appears on the product page. With save, we can fill out the form and have the product in the database, but hidden from public view for "random RUNs."
